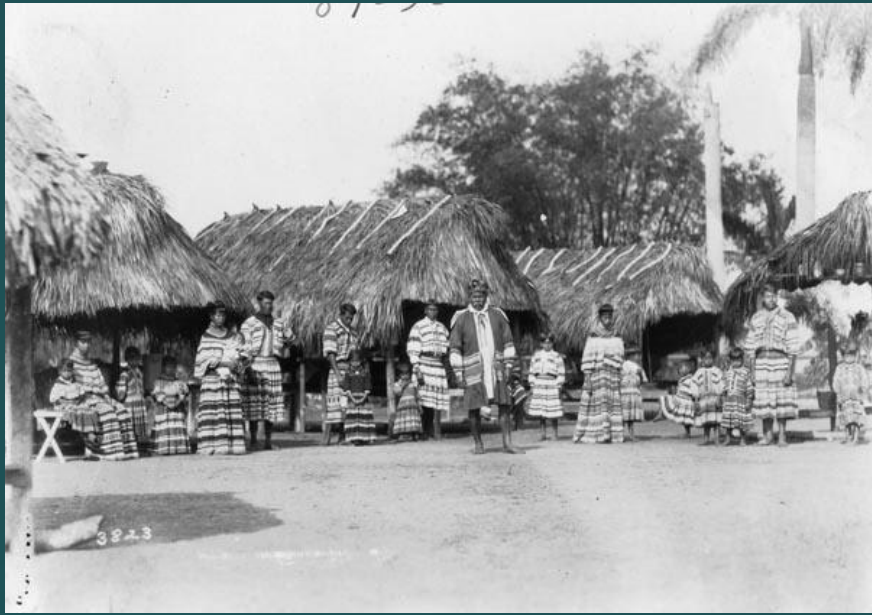
Challenge 4: Green Treasures- My Food Story

We further acknowledge that the people of the Tequesta and Calusa have also lived and thrived on these lands.

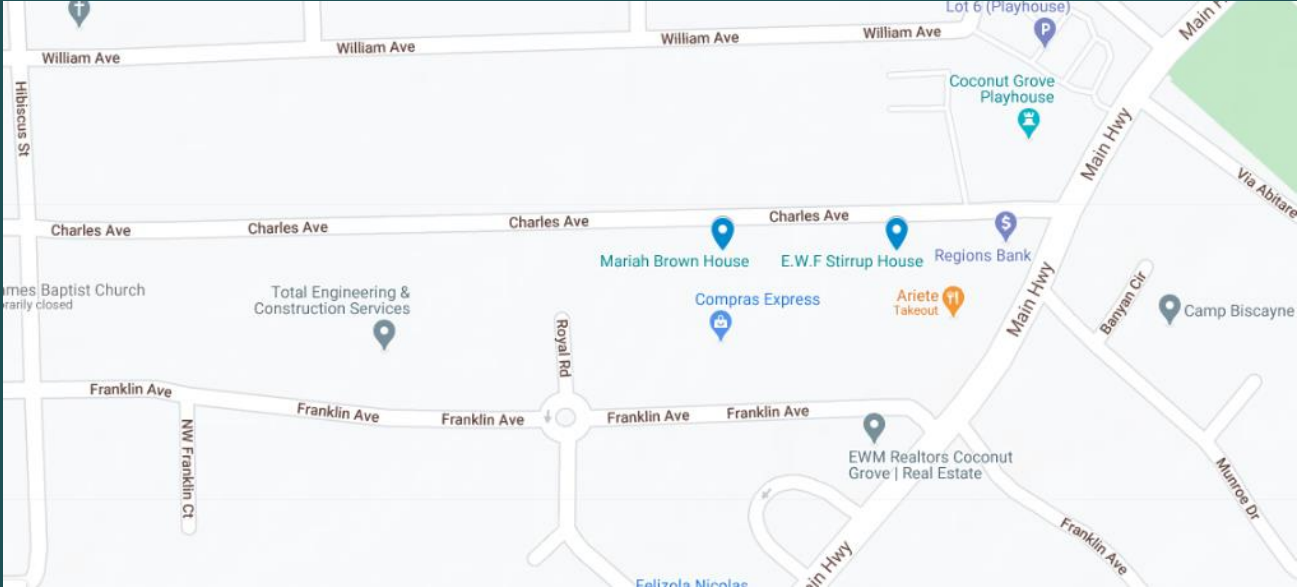
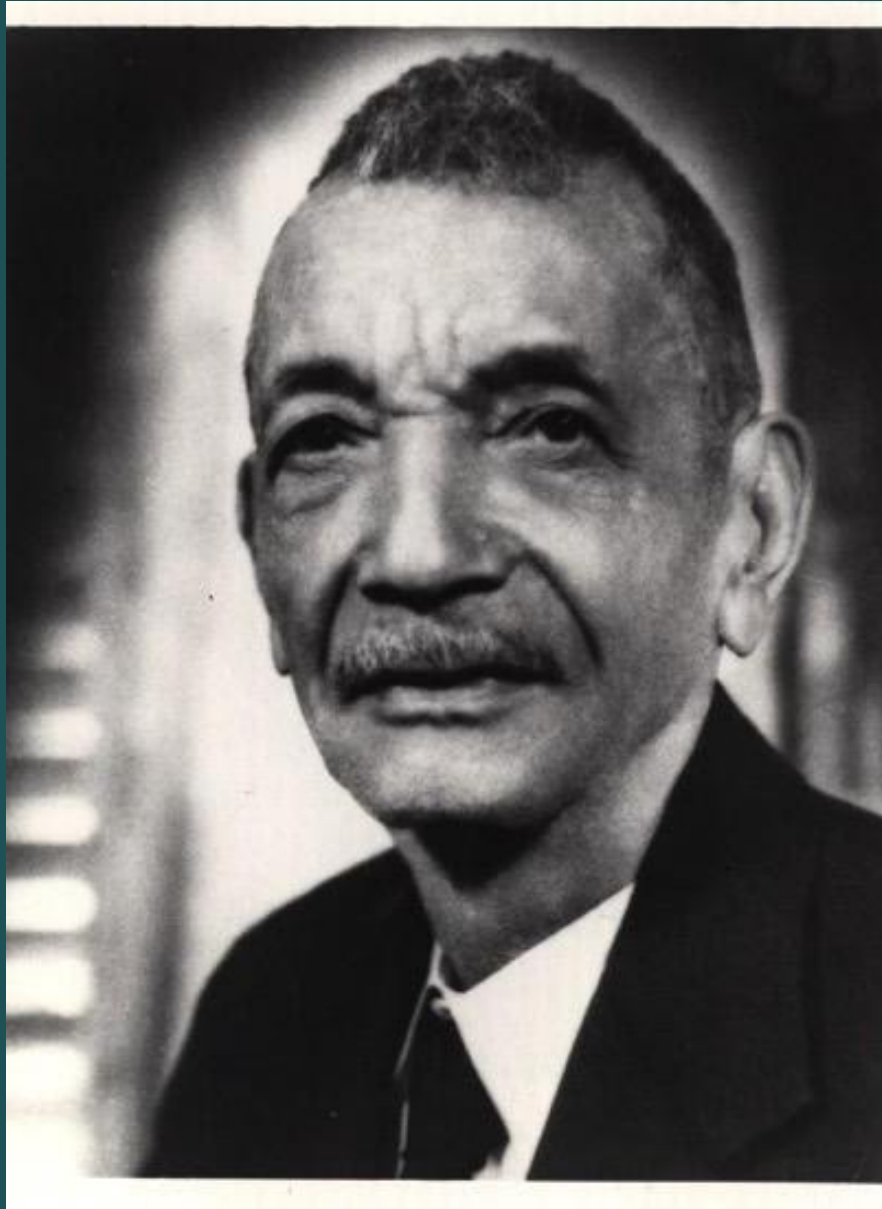

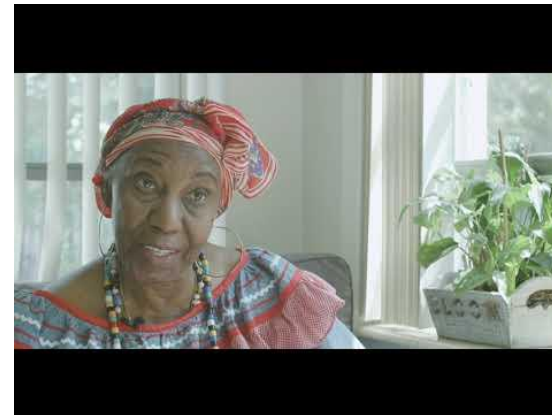
HOW DOES FOOD UNITE US?
