

Where To Stay In Miami With Family 2023 – 6 Best Areas

1. Key Biscayne

Arguably the best area to stay in Miami with family is Key Biscayne, which is an island south of Miami South Beach.

This **family-friendly area offers a beautiful, long beach** as well as **two state parks** where you can even see the nesting sea turtles.

As you're on an island, you're secluded and away from the chaos and the accommodations that you can find in this part took advantage of that: you can find proper, **upscale rooms here**, although it's mostly house and apartment rentals here that you find instead of hotels.
