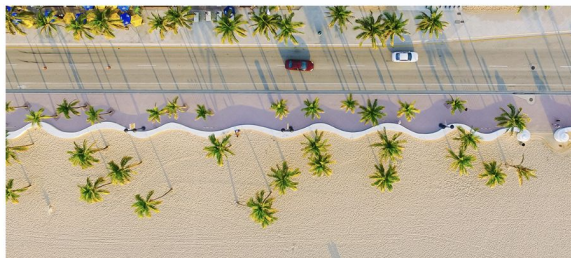

FAIRCHILD TROPICAL BOTANIC GARDEN

THROUGH SEPT. 4 Spend a family day this summer at [Fairchild Tropical Botanic Garden](#) exploring [Dragons & Mythical Creatures](#). On backcountry trails tucked amongst lush foliage, you'll encounter 16 majestic animatronics, including smoke-breathing dragons and legendary creatures that spark the imagination. Using the Fairchild App or by scanning codes along the trail you can embark on an interactive adventure. Other options include **A Dragoners Waterquest** (\$9.95), an adventure through watering holes and water-blasting challenges; the ticket includes a water gun. On select days, **Princess Tales & Tea on the Terrace** (kids \$24.95, adults \$15.95) is offered; meet the princess and enjoy an hour of tales, tea and princess crown crafts.
