Mango madness: While you may be tired of seeing mangoes, **Fairchild Tropical Botanic Garden** in **Coral Gables** is not. The Fairchild's annual **Mango Festival** returns 10 a.m.-5 p.m. Saturday and Sunday to celebrate the more than **400 varieties** of the fruit in its prized collection and what to do with them. You'll find discussions and cooking demos, as well as fresh mango smoothies, specialty mango cocktails, beer tastings, food, live music and family friendly games.
