Accessibility: Fairchild Tropical Botanic Garden is wheelchair accessible. The Garden offers disabled parking at its various parking areas. They also offer wheelchairs available for loan at no charge on a first-come, first-served basis at all of the entry points to the Garden.

They ensure accessibility to all of their exhibits and accessible paths to all of their buildings. The trams accommodate individuals with disabilities and are equipped with assisted listening aids. The Garden offers accessible restrooms in every public building, including the Visitor Center, AP Arts Building, Corbin Education Building, Garden House, and Glasshouse Café.

They also offer a shuttle service to guests with disabilities. Shuttles provide transportation from one location to another within the Garden. Please inquire about shuttle service availability at entrance locations.
