Pencils

1-2 number 2 pencils. Also known as 2H pencils Any brand pencil will do.

Vine Charcoal

I package of "hard" vine charcoal (a 3 pack is ok).

Charcoal Pencils

1-2 charcoal pencils 4B or 6B

1-2 white charcoal pencils

White pastel

1-2 white soft pastels, also known as chalk pastels

No oil pastels!

Eraser

1 white plastic eraser. Any brand, avoid gummy erasers

Pencil sharpener

Any small handheld pencil sharpener. The small inexpensive metal ones work well.

A pad or sketchbook of tinted or lightly colored paper

Strathmore 500 Series Charcoal Pad - 18" x 24" Assorted Tints is the best choice. If you don't want a whole pad, you can purchase another brand of lightly colored charcoal/drawing paper. Canson makes good papers in single sheets.

Please buy tinted/lightly colored paper and not white paper!

Drawing board

Any drawing board will do, but I use 20x30 half inch thick black foam board and it works better than most drawing boards.

White artist tape. Any brand

Printed photo in black and white of any person's face you wish to draw.

It's possible to work from digital files on a phone or tablet, but not recommended.
