

# Charcoal Portrait Class with Artist Dan Bondroff Supply List

## **Pencils**

1-2 number 2 pencils. Also known as 2H pencils  
Any brand pencil will do.

## **Vine Charcoal**

1 package of "hard" vine charcoal (a 3 pack is ok).

## **Charcoal Pencils**

1-2 charcoal pencils 4B or 6B  
1-2 white charcoal pencils

## **White pastel**

1-2 white soft pastels, also known as chalk pastels

## **No oil pastels!**

## **Eraser**

1 white plastic eraser. Any brand, avoid gummy erasers

## **Pencil sharpener**

Any small handheld pencil sharpener. The small inexpensive metal ones work well.

## **A pad or sketchbook of tinted or lightly colored paper**

Strathmore 500 Series Charcoal Pad - 18" x 24" Assorted Tints is the best choice.  
If you don't want a whole pad, you can purchase another brand of lightly colored charcoal/drawing paper. Canson makes good papers in single sheets.

## **Please buy tinted/lightly colored paper and not white paper!**

## **Drawing board**

Any drawing board will do, but I use 20x30 half inch thick black foam board and it works better than most drawing boards.

## **White artist tape.** Any brand

## **Printed photo in black and white of any person's face you wish to draw.**

It's possible to work from digital files on a phone or tablet, but not recommended.
