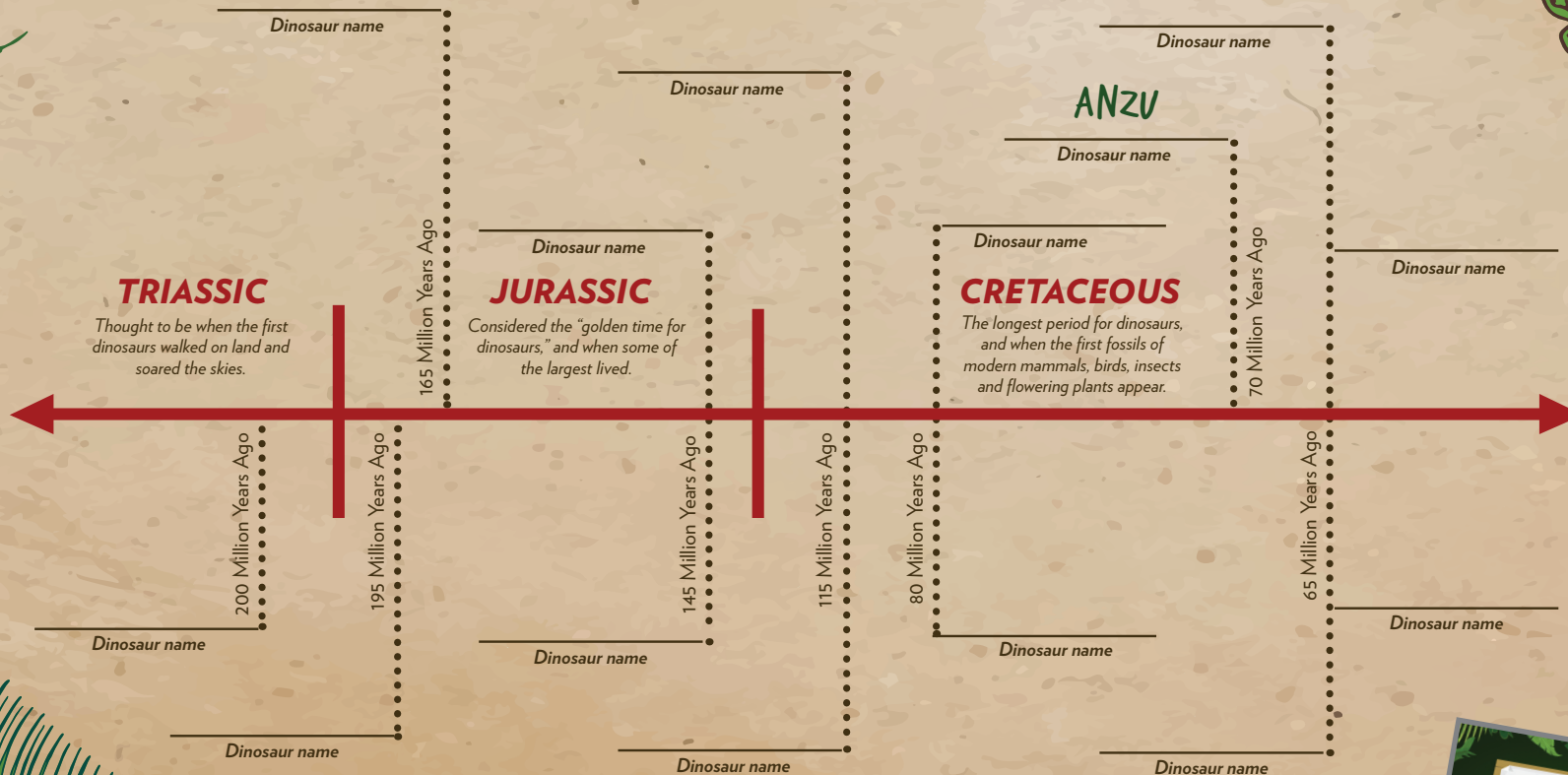

MEZOSOIC TIMELINE

The Mesozoic Era is considered the "Age of Reptiles," when dinosaurs ruled the land. The Triassic, Jurassic and Cretaceous periods take place during the Mesozoic Era.
